•<u>What is dyslexia?</u> Dyslexia is a specific learning disability that is neurobiological in origin. It is characterized by difficulties with accurate and/or fluent word recognition and by poor spelling and decoding abilities. These difficulties typically result from a deficit in the phonological component of language that is often unexpected in relation to other cognitive abilities and the provision of effective classroom instruction. Secondary consequences may include problems in reading comprehension and reduced reading experience that can impede the growth of vocabulary and background knowledge.

•**Effective strategies:** Provide multisensory experiences, pre-teach vocabulary, allow time for processing at their own pace, graphic novels, provide audiobooks when needed, break down tasks, and use visual supports.

•<u>Characteristics of dyslexia</u>: Students with dyslexia may have difficulty mispronouncing words, mapping sounds to letters, auditory memory for rhymes, songs, and chants, blending words in isolation or reading unknown words, fluency, spelling, vocabulary, reading comprehension, and writing.

•<u>Possible accommodations for state testin2 as prescribed by the ARD/504</u> <u>committee:</u> Reminders to stay on task, small group or individual testing, content and language supports, text-to-speech, speech-to-text, extra time, oral administration, spelling assistance, and writing predictor.
